INTRODUCTION.


STEMAZING is a non-profit social enterprise on a mission to drive an inspiration and inclusion revolution in STEM and amplify the voice of women in STEM.

Founded in 2020 by engineer and diversity advocate, <u>Alex Knight</u>. Our aim is to empower and equip an army of everyday, relatable role models to build a STEM movement that drives real change.

To date, our flagship multi award-winning training programme - The Inspiration Academy - has trained over **700 women in STEM** to level-up as visible role models and delivered **over 165,000 high-impact STEM engagements** for young children aged 7 - 9 years old in areas of high socio-economic need.

INSPIRATION ACADEMY.

The **STEMAZING** Inspiration Academy supports women and non-binary people in STEM to shine as visible role models and inspires children through fun, interactive online STEM sessions.

The participants complete our award-winning training programme to build their public engagement skills and confidence on camera, plus their STEM delivery toolbox.

These newly empowered role models then go on to deliver a 4-week programme of live online STEM sessions designed to engage children aged 7 - 9 years old.

Schools benefit from this fully-funded programme by taking part in hands-on simple STEM activities and experiments to promote children's curiosity, creativity and courage led by a STEM role model.

Thanks to our Partners we can deliver this programme free of charge to all selected schools, including delivery of a STEMKit with the key resources your class needs to do each experiment. To participate, please register your interest below.

ROLE MODELS



3 MONTH PROGRAMME.



This unique 3-month online course supports women and non-binary people to excel at public engagement, change outdated perceptions and leave a legacy by delivering engaging **STEMAZINGKids** sessions to inspire the next generation. It runs twice a year (March - May and September - November) and requires 2 hours a week time commitment.

All training is online, and delivery may be online or in-person depending on your distance to your matched school. Participants will need to:

- Attend the monthly live webinars.
- Sign up to be a STEM Ambassador with STEM Learning UK (for those based in the UK).
- Complete the empowering online training and bitesized homework.
- Engage with your assigned Accountability Group led by a mentor, for peer support.
- Liaise with your matched Primary school.
- Commit to delivering 4 **STEMAZINGKids** sessions, after completion of your training.
- Comply with our privacy and safeguarding policies.

On completion graduates can join the **STEMAZING Online Community** to benefit from ongoing support, empowerment and inspiration ideas and go on to become SIA Accountability Group Mentors, helping to shape the confidence and growth of participants in subsequent rounds of the programme. MONTH 1 - EMPOWER

Training designed to overcome limiting beliefs, build confidence and enhance public engagement skills.



MONTH 2 - EQUIP

Tutorials and group coaching to grow STEM outreach skills and toolbox aimed at a Primary audience.



MONTH 3 - ENGAGE

Role model matched with a Primary class with high % free-school-meals to deliver 4 **STEMAZINGKids** sessions. Resources sent to school in advance.

FUNDING.

For role models the programme is £1,497 + VAT. These are the different ways you can fund your Inspiration Academy place.

- Your organisation is a **STEMAZING Partner** so you can get an automatic place. Our **STEMAZING** Partners benefit from a number of places on this programme included in our Partnership packages and can also purchase additional places individually.
- You ask **your organisation** to pay for you from your annual training budget. If you don't ask you don't get! To help you make the business justification for this investment we have a **letter template** you can use.
- You want to invest in your own development through **self-funding** your spot. Yes! Go you!
- A **sponsor** funds your place, such as a professional institution e.g. the IMechE, sponsor a number of places for women in their membership, or an individual e.g. an ally or mentor, may also sponsor your place.
- You are applying for a fully-funded **STEMAZING Scholarship** free for any women in STEM to apply! Please note places are limited and are prioritised for women out of work who want to return to STEM.

REGISTRATION.

Registration opens twice a year.

In the **Spring/Summer** round of the programme, registration opens in **January**. Down-selection and notification of scholarship places takes place in **February**. Training starts in **March**. **STEMAZINGKids** sessions are delivered in **May**.

In the **Autumn/Winter** round, registration opens **July**. Down-selection and notification takes place in **August**. Training starts in **September**. **STEMAZINGKids** sessions are delivered in **November**.

PRIMARY SCHOOLS



PRIMARY SCHOOLS.

STEM is the combination of Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths. It actively promotes a young person's curiosity, creativity and courage. Not enough children have the opportunity to explore and engage in STEM activities. We want to change that!

The **STEMAZING** Inspiration Academy is a fully-funded i.e. FREE, 4 week programme of live online STEM sessions designed to engage and inspire primary school children aged 7 - 9 years.

Each week the children take part in a 1-hour activity over Zoom (or Teams or Google Meet) using basic, everyday resources. Children create their own STEM masterpiece each week using these resources. Resources a.k.a STEMKits, will be sent to your school at no cost, prior to the session delivery.

All sessions are delivered by a woman/non-binary person in STEM, to showcase role models and support changing outdated perceptions of what a scientist, technologist, engineer or mathematician might look like.

4 WEEK PROGRAMME.

WHAT WILL YOU DO?

- 4 x 1-hour STEM sessions will delivered live by a role model.
- Each session will focus on a different science or engineering principle through a simple hands-on activity each child engages with, including structures, aerodynamics, energy and sustainability.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- All sessions will be delivered online. Some sessions may be in-person if we are able to match a role model that lives locally to a school.
- These sessions are best run in school time so the whole class can participate.
- You can agree the best time to run the live sessions with your assigned role model in advance.

WHAT WILL YOU NEED?

- We will send the key resources needed for the 4 STEM experiments for each class of 30 children taking part, including simple things such as cardboard tubes, straws, balloons, pom-poms, skewers etc.
- Your school will need to provide paper, colouring pens, scissors, glue sticks and print the templates that we provide electronically.



STEMKITS.

Each STEMKit is for 30 students. If you have more than 30 students in the class, you will received more than one kit. The kit will arrive in the weeks leading up to the sessions being delivered.

Each STEMKit contains:

- 30 cardboard tubes
- 60 wooden skewers
- 30 balloons
- 10 paper straws
- 1 roll of masking tape
- 1 pack of blutac
- 30 pom-pom projectiles

Details of how to sort the STEMKit resources for the 4 sessions and what the school needs to provide, is provided in the kit.














REGISTRATION.


Registration opens twice a year.

In the **Spring/Summer** round of the programme, registration for schools opens in **January**. If your schools is selected, notification will be in **March**. Live STEM sessions will be delivered in school in **May/June**.

In the **Autumn/Winter** round, registration opens in **June**. If selected, notification will be **September**. The sessions will be delivered in **November/December**.

ACCESS STEM ONLINE

HOME SCHOOLS.

The **STEMAZING** Inspiration Academy is open to homeschoolers, homebased educators and the home education community.

Access FREE homeschool STEM online and engage your child/children in a series of 4 fully-funded 1-hour interactive STEM workshops for 7-9 year olds. Children will learn about **STEMAZING** Structures, Amazing Aerodynamics, Energy Explorers and Planet Protectors.

The Homeschool Class will be delivered online and led by an experienced woman in STEM role model, utilising simple household items. You will need a cardboard tube, 2 wooden skewers, a balloon, a paper straw, some sticky/masking tape, some blutac, and a pom-pom.

Homeschoolers in various different locations, will sign in to the session at the same time, in a virtual classroom. Links to sign in will be emailed once you have registered for the individual sessions. Sessions will be supported by a member of the **STEMAZING** team.


REGISTRATION.


